- He has for 25 years served as Steering Committee member of the National Workers' Compensation Institute (NCI) (formerly FWCI), which puts on the annual Workers' Compensation Educational Conference, now in its 68th year.

George is particularly proud of the following three appointments:

• He remains co-chair, and annual presenter, at the *National Workers' Compensation Review*, which he founded and where in 2016 and again in 2017 he presented in a joint special session on "Wither the grand bargain/Constitutional crisis in Worker's Compensation and on 'Faith Based Claims,' a unique annual presentation of the NWCR.

George is also proud of having received the 1994 *Friends of 440 Award*, as distinguished defense attorney honoree for the year, and *The Bud Adams' Award* for professionalism a few years earlier.

George received his J.D. degree from the University of Miami in 1975 and his B.A. from the University of South Florida in 1972.
